This position is responsible for assisting Engineers, Landscape Architects and other professionals on civil/site development and related planning, design, and construction projects. Project types may include, but are not limited to, site development, streets, water resources and environmental. Specific responsibilities include managing and directing field crew activities, interacting with clients, conducting boundary research, organizing, and conducting field surveys including route and property surveys, preparation of right-of-way plats, ALTA Surveys, data reduction, calculations, and overseeing the preparation of topographic maps and site plans from survey information collected.

Perform field surveying as 1-person field crew utilizing GPS and robotic total station equipment. Field surveying to include boundary, topographic & stream surveys and construction staking layout. Survey Office Tasks - Download collected survey data and generate survey base files utilizing AutoCAD Civil 3D. Compute & prepare surveying staking point files and upload to data collector.

Perform AutoCAD Civil 3D drafting for engineering & landscape architectural design projects. Maintain survey data databases & records.
